STARTING FTTH FROM SCRATCH


Overview

Wilson Greenlight is North Carolina's first community-owned, symmetrical gigabit, fiber-to-the home-network in the state. It represents more than 15 years of planning, designing, and fighting for a future-proof infrastructure that was the natural outflow for a community characterized by a long history of self-reliance, and infrastructure focus. Throughout its development, Greenlight's guiding principles have remained:

- 1. Supporting the economic health of the community,
- 2. Improving the delivery of city services and
- 3. Enhancing the quality of life for the citizens of Wilson.

The Challenge

In 2007, the City began constructing what it saw as critical public infrastructure in a global economy dependent on the internet: a fiber-to-the-home network. With regard to FTTH infrastructure, what engineering, cable, closures, and hardware, both overhead and underground, are to be used? After screening many potential manufacturers, Greenlight narrowed its' list of approved manufacturers.



The Solution

With much consideration and research, Greenlight chose many of PLP's closures, cable dead-ends, cable supports, vibration dampers, and Groundline Closures (GLC). The water-tightness of PLP's closures aided Greenlight with keeping splices water-free. The interchangeability of the PLP cable Grommet system between closures aided in efficiency. PLP also partnered with Greenlight on several occasions, providing in-house training, and with Greenlight piloting potential new PLP products for feedback – good and bad.
